Parent Information During COVID:

Program Operations and Dates:

- All programs will begin on September 1 and will operate on a regular, full day, basis unless otherwise noted on our C.E.S Special Education Calendar.
- You will be promptly notified if a local or state department of health orders schools to be closed. At that point remote learning plans will be implemented.
- You may choose a remote learning plan for your child in lieu of regular enrollment. Please contact your child's program administrator for further information.

Student Health:

- In order to ensure a safe school environment for all students, sick children should not be sent to school. If your child has a fever, sore throat, chills, nauseous/vomiting, or other symptoms consistent with a cold or flu, do not send them to school.
- If your child arrives at school sick or becomes ill during the day you will be contacted by the nurse and asked to pick up your child. If you are not available we will contact someone from your contact list. It is essential that you only put people on that list who have access to a car and can pick your child up from school.
- In the event that your child experiences COVID like symptoms in school, they will be taken to a quarantine space by staff and evaluated by our nurse. You will be contacted by the nurse and give further instructions. The nurse may ask that your child get a COVID test and remain out of school until he/she is medically cleared to return.
- If you or a family member is exposed to, or diagnosed with COVID, we ask that you
 contact one of our nurses immediately. We also ask that you not send your child to
 school until he/she is medically cleared to return.

Parent Visitors, Drop off Pick Up:

- To limit the amount of people in our buildings we are not allowing visitors to enter the school during the day. If you think you have a special circumstance you must contact your child's program administrator. The administrator has the final decision making authority with respect to acceptions.
- Should your child have an early dismissal, you are asked to come to the front door and communicate with our receptionist via the intercom. Your child will be brought outside to you.
- You may choose to transport your child to and from school. You are asked to park in one
 of our visitor parking spots in the front of the building and wait for a staff member to bring
 your child into the building. You may bring your child to the front of the building and leave
 them with staff who are already outside so long as you follow all safety rules and
 procedures.
- All parent meetings and PPTs will be done via phone or other electronic medium.

Lunch and Materials:

- School lunch will be provided as usual. Students will eat in their classrooms or in other
 designated spaces inside or outside of the building. Microwaves and ovens will be
 limited. We ask that if your child needs a warm or hot lunch that you send it in a
 theamous or other insulated container. Please stay in contact with your child's teacher if
 you have individual needs or questions.
- We ask that you send any school supplies in a resealable zip lock bag. We also ask that
 you clean/disinfect any supplies that are brought to and from school.

Masks and PPE:

- All students must wear masks while on the bus and in school. Please contact your child's program administrator if you have concerns about this policy.
- We will provide disposable masks for students who need them but we strongly
 encourage you to send your child to school with their own personal masks. If
 possible, please send them in with an extra supply of masks.
- You are welcome to send your child with a face shield. These are not required but are allowable should you choose to send them.
- We also ask that you send a full change of clothes to school.

Communication during this time is critical to all of our safety. We will be sure to let you know if there are any changes to our procedures, policies, or schuleds. In turn, we ask that you keep us advised of any problems, concerns, or changes in circumstances. Our goal is to open on September 1 and remain fully opened for the entire school year. If we work together we can achieve this goal.

From Merritt Parkway - Northbound

(Exit 48 - Main Street) - Take a right at end of exit ramp

At 2nd traffic light (.4 miles), take left onto Old Town Rd. At third stop sign, **continue straight.** C.E.S. is the first building on your left (enter on side).

From Merritt Parkway - Southbound

Exit 50 - Take a right at end of exit ramp onto White Plains Road.

At third traffic light (approximately .8 mile) make a left onto Reservoir Avenue. Follow (1 mile) to Lindeman Drive. Take a right onto Lindeman Drive, follow (.5 miles) to stop sign. Take a left onto Oakview Drive. Continue on Oakview to first stop sign. Take a left at stop sign. C.E.S. is the first building on your left (enter on side).

From Connecticut Turnpike (I-95)

Either Southbound or Northbound:

Take Route 8/25 Connector North (exit 27A). Follow signs for Route 25. Take White Plains Road Exit 7(Route 127). At end of ramp, turn left onto White Plains Rd. At traffic light (.4 miles), take left onto Reservoir Avenue. Follow (1 mile) to Lindeman Drive. Take a right onto Lindeman Drive, (go past the C.E.S. Admin. Building) follow (.5 miles) to stop sign. Take a left onto Oakview Drive. Continue on Oakview to first stop sign. Take a left at stop sign. C.E.S. is the first building on your left.

From Route 8 South

Route 8 South to Merritt Parkway (route 15, Exit 10). Follow Merritt Parkway (.5 miles) to White Plains Road (Route 127) Exit 50. Take a right at the end of the exit. Follow White Plains Road (1 mile). At third traffic light (Reservoir Ave.) take a left. Follow (1 mile) to Lindeman Drive. Take a right onto Lindeman Drive, follow (.5 miles) to stop sign. Take a left onto Oakview Drive. Continue on Oakview to first stop sign. Take a left at stop sign. C.E.S. is the first building on your left.

From Route 25 - Danbury Area

Take Route 25 south to Exit 9 - Daniels Farm Road. At end of exit, take left. Take right at stop sign onto Daniels Farm Road.
