Make 10



You need


- deck of Primary Number Cards 7 4 (without Wild Cards)
- blank sheet of paper

Play with a partner.

- Deal 4 rows of 5 cards, with the numbers showing.
- Player 1 finds two cards that make 10. Player 1 takes the cards and records the combination of 10.
- 3 Replace the missing cards with 2 cards from the deck.
- Player 2 finds two cards that make 10. Player 2 takes the cards and records the combination of 10.
- Replace the missing cards.
- Keep taking turns finding two cards that make 10 and recording.
- The game is over when there are no more cards or there are no more cards that make 10.

More Ways to Play

- Play with the Wild Cards. A Wild Card can be any number.
- Replace the cards only when there are no more pairs that make 10.
- Find more than 2 cards that make 10.



Questions to ask before:

How many cards did you lay out? How can you find out or check how many cards you have?

Questions to ask during:

- How did you know those cards made 10? Is there another way to add it up?
- Does the order of the numbers matter?
- How can the pictures help you?
- Can you make a 10 with that card? Do you see the number you need?
- What does zero mean?

Questions to ask after:

- Can you write or tell a story problem to go with these cards?
- Instead of using combinations of 2 numbers to make 10, can you use 3 numbers?
